# The UKPSA 100

---

## Winter Postal League For IPSC Action Air Sponsors – Practical Shooting Supplies

UKPSA Open Postal League for the months of November, December, January & February. It is free to enter and all shooters are invited to participate. These are all standard exercises that are designed to be simple to set up and run at any club shoot. Team entries are also free.

Register and enter scores via ShootnScoreit. <http://shootnscoreit.com/ipsc/match/6230/>

One club member may apply for access to SSI to enter scores or you can still post or email them in.

The stages may be shot at any time over the four month period. The stages do not have to be completed in one go. Your club may choose to shoot a few stages each week.

These are standard courses of fire. Shooters may enter more than one division.

Medals will be awarded to the division winners. Other medals awarded depending on number of entrants in each division.

**Team Entries** – 3 or 4 members shooting in same division. Best three scores to count. Team members must be bona fide members of the same club. They may enter in more than one team if shooting in a different gun division. Register your team via email to [postal leagues@ukpsa.org](mailto:postal leagues@ukpsa.org) Clubs can enter more than one team in a division.

**Scoring** – All stages will be comstock scored.

**Targets** - all targets are IPSC Mini (2/3) Targets. The bottom of the targets will be approx.. 1.5 meters from the ground. Targets will have a gap of 10cm (4") where they are in a line. Targets can be obtained from <http://www.doublealpha.biz>

**Distances** - will be measured from targets to front of shooting box or rear of table.

**Start Positions** There are two start positions.

Start Position 1 (SP1) - Gun in holster. Standing up right in shooting box which is 1m square, with arms hanging naturally by your sides.

Start Position 2 (SP2). - Gun wholly on table. Standing upright behind table with arms hanging naturally by your side.

**Start conditions** will be given in each stage. All shooting must take place from the shooting box or from behind the confines of the table. Unloaded starts – ammunition may be on your belt in a magazine or placed on table in stages 8 and 11.

**Reloads.** At least one round must be inserted into the gun.

**Gun Divisions.** Standard, Open, Production or Classic

**Categories.** Regular, Lady, Senior, Super Senior or Junior. Please register your division and category on ShootnScoreit.

## The UKPSA 100 Courses of Fire

<b>Stage 1</b>	<b>UKPSA 100 - 1</b>	<b>Rounds</b>	
Targets – 3. Distance 10m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a minimum of two rounds on each.		6	
<b>Stage 2</b>	<b>UKPSA 100 - 2</b>		
Targets – 3. Distance 7m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a minimum of two rounds on each.		6	
<b>Stage 3</b>	<b>UKPSA 100 - 3</b>		
Targets – 3. Distance 5m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a minimum of two rounds on each. Strong hand only.		6	
<b>Stage 4</b>	<b>UKPSA 100 - 4</b>		
Targets – 3. Distance 5m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a maximum of two rounds on each. Carry out a compulsory reload and again shoot the targets with a minimum of two rounds on each.		12	
<b>Stage</b>	<b>5</b>	<b>UKPSA 100 - 5</b>	
Targets – 2. Distance 5m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with one round only on each. Carry out a compulsory reload and again shoot the targets with two rounds only on each. Carry out a second reload and engage the targets with a minimum of three rounds on each.		12	
<b>Stage 6</b>	<b>UKPSA 100 - 6</b>		
Targets – 3. Distance 5m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a maximum of two rounds on each, freestyle. Carry out a compulsory reload and again shoot the targets with a minimum of one round on each, strong hand only.		9	

### **Stage 7**                    **UKPSA 100 - 7**

Targets – 3. Distance 5m. Start condition Loaded SP1.  
On audible start signal, shoot targets with a maximum of two rounds on each, freestyle. Carry out a compulsory reload and again shoot the targets with one round on each, weak hand only.                    9

### **Stage 8**                    **UKPSA 100 - 8**

Targets – 3. Distance 5m. Start Condition Unloaded, SP2. All ammunition for the stage on the table in magazines. On audible start signal, shoot the targets with a minimum of two rounds on each.                    6

### **Stage 9**                    **UKPSA 100 - 9**

Targets – 3. Distance 5m. Start Condition Loaded, Chamber empty, SP2. On audible start signal, shoot the targets with a minimum of two rounds on each.                    6

### **Stage 10**                    **UKPSA 100 - 10**

Targets – 3. Distance 5m. Start Condition Loaded, SP2.  
On audible start signal, shoot the targets with a minimum of two on each, weak hand only.                    6

### **Stage 11**                    **UKPSA 100 - 11**

Targets – 1. Distance 5m. Start Condition unloaded. SP2  
All ammunition required for the stage on the table. On audible start signal, shoot the target with a minimum of six rounds, freestyle.                    6

### **Stage 12**                    **UKPSA 100 - 12**

Targets – 1. Distance 5m. Start Condition Loaded. SP2.  
On audible start signal, shoot the target with a minimum of six rounds, freestyle.                    6

### **Stage 13**                    **UKPSA 100 - 13**

Targets – 5. Distance 5m. Start Condition Loaded. SP1.  
On audible start signal, shoot the targets with a maximum of one round on each. Carry out a compulsory reload and again shoot the targets with a minimum of one round on each.                    10
