## The 2017 UKPSA Postal League for Practical Long Barrelled Firearms.

This Postal League is open to all shooters and is free to enter. It is made up of four rounds and each will have four stages. Each round will require 50 rounds minimum. Stages will be simple to set up, with common props, screens and apertures. Some of the stages are standard exercises. The league is ideal for a club practice session or as part of a match.

Team entries will also be accepted for 2017, again free to enter. Three or four team members, all shooting the same division, with the best three scores to count. All team members must be from the same club and should shoot all four rounds to achieve the best scores.

### Administration

If you are the club organiser, make sure you fill in the **Club Contacts Form** and ensure you have one (or two) contacts. These **must** have an email address. The second form is a **Team Registration Form**. Fill one of these in for each team. The final form is **Competitor Registration Form**, and I require one of these for each competitor. There are two on the page to save you paper. I only require this the **first time** a competitor shoots, unless he/she changes division, e.g. gun out of action or a new gun, in which case they will be treated as a new competitor.

Score sheets for Round 2 are also attached. After Round 1 competitor numbers will be allocated. Please use this number for subsequent rounds.

Each round will take place as follows

Round 1 in \* **Complete** \*

Round 3 in **July & August**

Round 2 in **May & June**

Round 4 in **September & October**

Scores will be calculated at the end of each round and results will be posted onto the UKPSA web site, Forum, and emailed to **Club Contacts**. At the conclusion of Round 4 overall winners of each competition will be declared. Divisions recognised are

LBR (Long Barrelled Revolver)	Standard and Open
LBP (Long Barrelled Pistol)	Standard and Open
CF (Centre Fire) Lever Action Rifle	Standard and Open
MR (Mini Rifle i.e Rim Fire) Rifle	Standard and Open.

Trophies will be awarded in each Division as follows. Over 15 entries, 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>. 10 – 14 entries 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>. 5 – 9 entries 1<sup>st</sup> only. Less than 5, no trophy awarded.

Competitors may only shoot **one** division for score. Please note that your **first attempt** must be used for your official score. This does not prevent re-shooting in another division for a fun, but please don't send in any scores.

The stages may be shot at any time within the two month period for each round. An RO and a witness are required to verify the competitor's score. All scores are to be recorded on the individual score sheets or the summary score sheet which will be published with the stages. The summary sheet is an Excel spreadsheet which you may fill in and email to me. This will be necessary if you use a scoring 'app' that doesn't have a print out facility. **I must have the number of 'A's 'C's etc - a single total is not acceptable.**

The stages will be posted out at the start of each round. Scores must be submitted to arrive not later than 5 days after the last day of each round.

All the stages are simple to set up and organisers are asked to keep to the measurements given. Targets will be **IPSC (full size) or Mini Targets (2/3)** either full or partial. These are available from Double Alpha Academy.

## **Alternative Start Position for handguns (Tyro)**

Some clubs forbid the drawing of a loaded handgun from a holster, and some, especially new, shooters may feel uncomfortable with it. To allow for this an alternative start position is allowed. Instead of starting with the gun in the holster, the shooter starts with gun in the strong hand with elbow touching side and forearm parallel to the ground, finger outside trigger guard. The weak arm is hanging naturally by side.

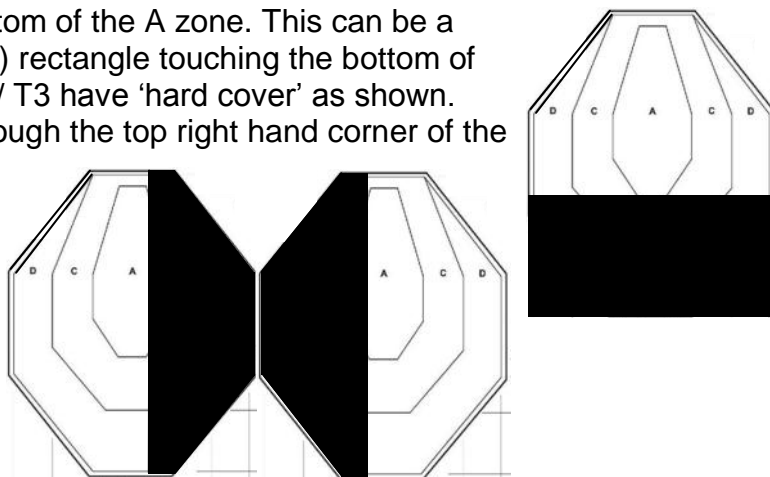
Non-holstered starts, e.g. gun placed on table, remain the same for all shooters.

## Round 2 Stage Construction Notes

- 1) Unless otherwise specified, the lowest point of a target or array is 1.4m from floor.
- 2) Shooting boxes are 600 x 600mm (2 x 2ft). Ideally, made from 50 x 50mm wood.
- 3) Distance to targets is from front of box or to rear of table, i.e. shooter's side.
- 4) Distances between boxes is centre to centre.

### Stage 5

T1 has hard cover touching the bottom of the A zone. This can be a black cardboard (or similar material) rectangle touching the bottom of the A zone; black tape or paint. T2 / T3 have 'hard cover' as shown. Draw the line passing Vertically through the top right hand corner of the A zone. Paint black or use black tape to the right of this line. Alternatively, a black rectangle can be used. Hits on the 'hard cover' do not incur penalties.



### Stage 6

Nothing special.

### Stage 7

- 1) This stage is Stage 5 and 6 targetry combined.

### Stage 8

- 1) This stage is Stage 7 targetry with the array below left and a full IPSC N/S added. N/S 1 has its left hand edge along the vertical centreline of T1. Targets T5 and T6 are edge to edge as shown. N/S 2 is directly below T6 and level with T7.

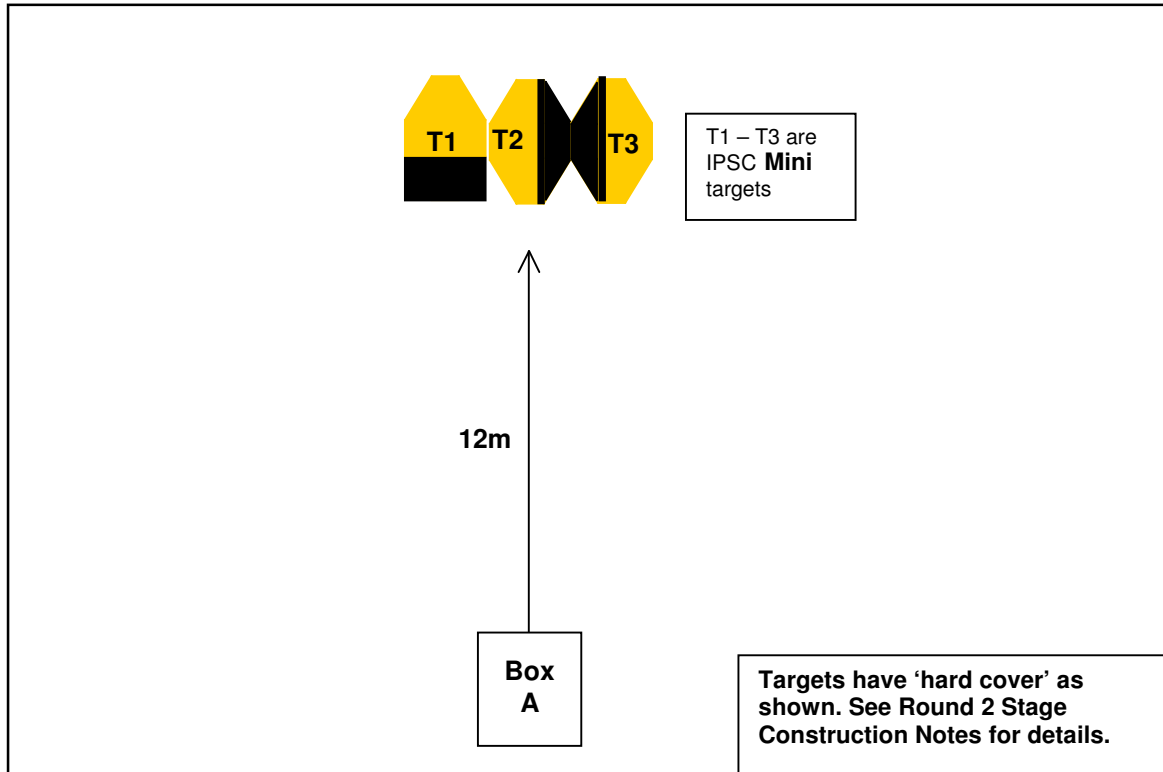

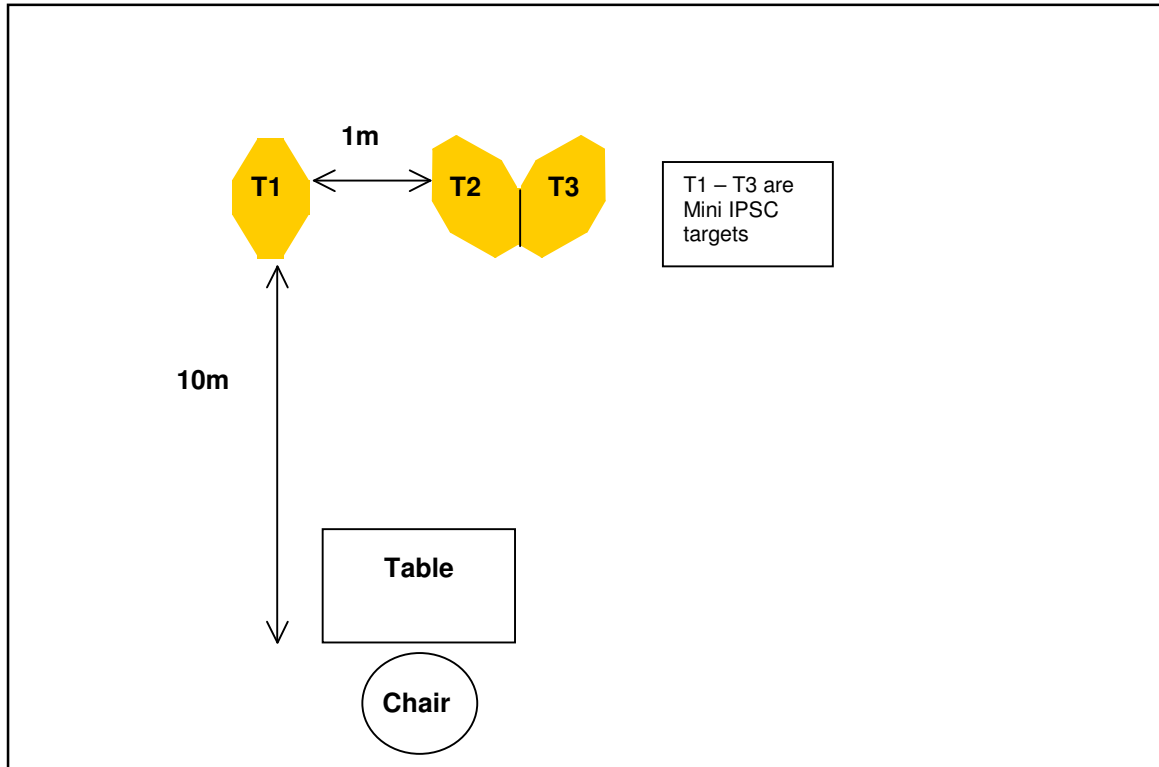

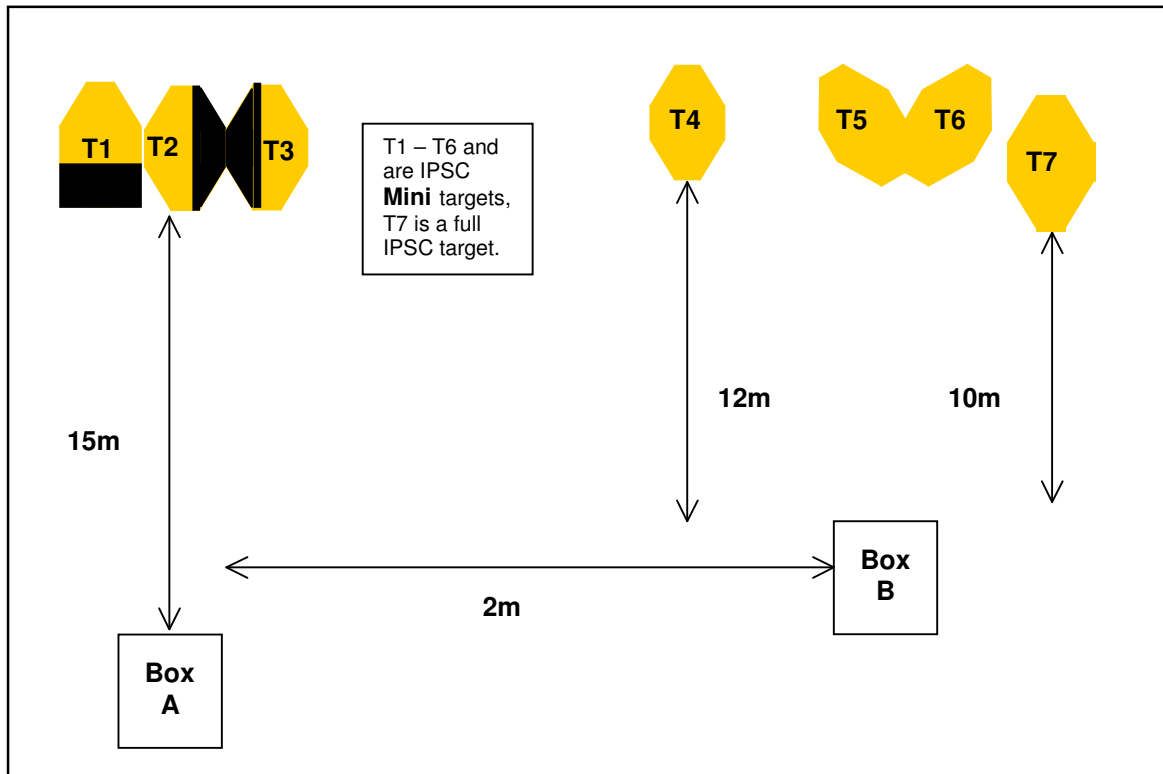

<b>TYPE:</b>	Short course.	<b>TARGETS:</b>	3 x Partial IPSC Mini Targets
<b>SCORING:</b>	Comstock.	<b>MINIMUM ROUNDS:</b>	9 Rounds
<b>DISTANCES:</b>	12m	<b>MAX POINTS:</b>	45 Points.
<b>START:</b>	Audible signal	<b>PENALTIES:</b>	As per current edition of IPSC Rule Book.
<b>STOP:</b>	Last shot.		
<b>START POSITION:</b>	Standing upright in Box A, Handguns - Gun loaded and in holster with arms hanging naturally by your sides. Rifles – loaded and held in two hands at hip level and parallel to the ground.		
<b>PROCEDURE:</b>	On the start signal, shoot all targets with a maximum of two shots on each. Reload with a minimum of one round and shoot all targets with a minimum of one shot on each. Hits on the 'hard cover' do not incur penalties.		
<b>DESIGN NOTES:</b>			
<b>BRIEFING NOTES:</b>	<b>Safety Angles:</b> 90 / 90 / 90. (MAR may be used)		



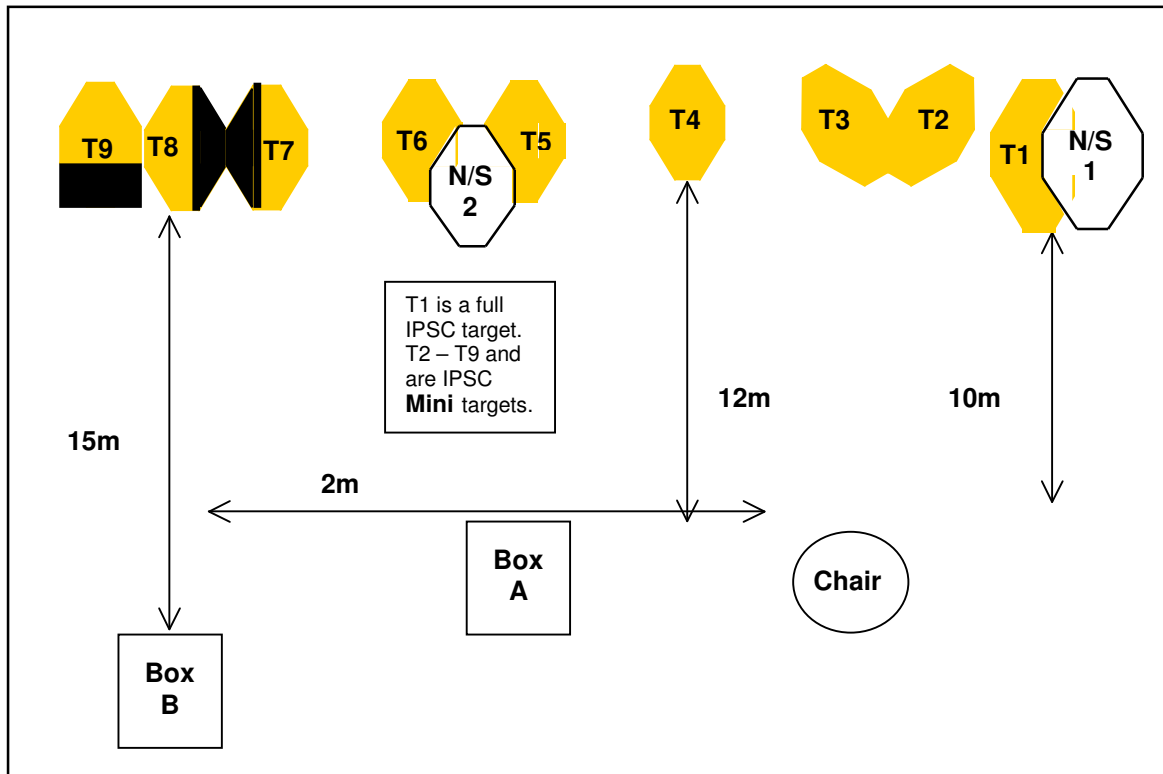
**STAGE 6 INFO**

<b>TYPE:</b>	Short course.	<b>TARGETS:</b>	3 Mini IPSC
<b>SCORING:</b>	Comstock.	<b>MINIMUM ROUNDS:</b>	12
<b>DISTANCE:</b>	10m	<b>MAX POINTS:</b>	60
<b>START:</b>	Audible signal	<b>PENALTIES:</b>	As per current edition of IPSC Rule Book.
<b>STOP:</b>	Last shot.		
<b>START POSITION:</b>	Sat at table, hands flat on knees. Unloaded gun placed wholly on table and completely covered by a hand towel. If gun is longer than table, butt to be completely on, barrel may overhang.		
<b>PROCEDURE:</b>	On the start signal, load and shoot all targets with a minimum of two shots on each from sitting position. Reload with a minimum of one round and shoot all targets with a minimum of two shots on each freestyle.		
<b>DESIGN NOTES:</b>			
<b>BRIEFING NOTES:</b>	<b>Safety Angles:</b> 90 / 90 / 90. (MAR may be used)

<b>TYPE:</b>	Medium course.	<b>TARGETS:</b>	6 x IPSC Mini Targets (2/3). 1 x IPSC Target
<b>SCORING:</b>	Comstock.	<b>MINIMUM ROUNDS:</b>	14 Rounds
<b>DISTANCES:</b>	10m – 15m	<b>MAX POINTS:</b>	70 Points.
<b>START:</b>	Audible signal	<b>PENALTIES:</b>	As per current edition of IPSC Rule Book.
<b>STOP:</b>	Last shot.		
<b>START POSITION:</b>	Standing upright in Box A, Handguns - Gun loaded and in holster with arms hanging naturally by your sides. Rifles – loaded and held in two hands at hip level and parallel to the ground.		
<b>PROCEDURE:</b>	On the start signal, load and shoot all targets with a minimum of two shots on each. Targets T1 – T3 must be taken from Box A, T4 – T7 from Box B. Hits on the ‘hard cover’ do not incur penalties.		
<b>DESIGN NOTES:</b>	This is stages 5 and 6 with a IPSC target, T7 added on the right.		
<b>BRIEFING NOTES:</b>	<b>Safety Angles:</b> 90 / 90 / 90. (MAR may be used)		



**STAGE 8 INFO**

<b>TYPE:</b>	Medium course.	<b>TARGETS:</b>	8 x IPSC Mini Targets (2/3). 1 x IPSC Target
<b>SCORING:</b>	Comstock.	<b>MINIMUM ROUNDS:</b>	18 Rounds
<b>DISTANCES:</b>	10m – 15m	<b>MAX POINTS:</b>	90 Points.
<b>START:</b>	Audible signal	<b>PENALTIES:</b>	As per current edition of IPSC Rule Book.
<b>STOP:</b>	Last shot.		
<b>START POSITION:</b>	Sat on chair, Handguns - Gun loaded and in holster with hands on knees. Rifles – loaded and held in strong hand at knee level and parallel to the ground. Weak hand on (weak) knee.		
<b>PROCEDURE:</b>	On the start signal, load and shoot all targets with a minimum of two shots on each. Targets T1 – T4 must be taken from vicinity of the chair (i.e. you may stand), T5 – T6 from Box A and T7 – T8 from Box B. Hits on the 'hard cover' do not incur penalties.		
<b>DESIGN NOTES:</b>	This is Stage 7 with two Mini IPSC targets, T5,T6 added in line with T7 – T9 and two no-shoots. See Round 2 Stage Construction Notes for details.
