The 2017 UKPSA Postal League for Practical Long Barrelled Firearms.

This Postal League is open to all shooters and is free to enter. It is made up of four rounds and each will have four stages. Each round will require 50 rounds minimum. Stages will be simple to set up, with common props, screens and apertures. Some of the stages are standard exercises. The league is ideal for a club practice session or as part of a match.

Team entries will also be accepted for 2017, again free to enter. Three or four team members, all shooting the same division, with the best three scores to count. All team members must be from the same club and should shoot all four rounds to achieve the best scores.

Administration

If you are the club organiser, make sure you fill in the **Club Contacts Form** and ensure you have one (or two) contacts. These **must** have an email address. The second form is a **Team Registration Form**. Fill one of these in for each team. The final form is **Competitor Registration Form**, and I require one of these for each competitor. There are two on the page to save you paper. I only require this the **first time** a competitor shoots, unless he/she changes division, e.g. gun out of action or a new gun, in which case they will be treated as a new competitor.

Score sheets for Round 3 are also attached. After Round 1 competitor numbers will be allocated. Please use this number for subsequent rounds.

Each round will take place as follows

Round 1 in * **Complete** *

Round 3 in **July & August**

Round 2 in * **Complete** *

Round 4 in **September & October**

Scores will be calculated at the end of each round and results will be posted onto the UKPSA web site, Forum, and emailed to **Club Contacts**. At the conclusion of Round 4 overall winners of each competition will be declared. Divisions recognised are

LBR (Long Barrelled Revolver)	Standard and Open
LBP (Long Barrelled Pistol)	Standard and Open
CF (Centre Fire) Lever Action Rifle	Standard and Open
MR (Mini Rifle i.e Rim Fire) Rifle	Standard and Open.

Trophies will be awarded in each Division as follows. Over 15 entries, 1st to 3rd. 10 – 14 entries 1st & 2nd. 5 – 9 entries 1st only. Less than 5, no trophy awarded.

Competitors may only shoot **one** division for score. Please note that your **first attempt** must be used for your official score. This does not prevent re-shooting in another division for a fun, but please don't send in any scores.

The stages may be shot at any time within the two month period for each round. An RO and a witness are required to verify the competitor's score. All scores are to be recorded on the individual score sheets or the summary score sheet which will be published with the stages. The summary sheet is an Excel spreadsheet which you may fill in and email to me. This will be necessary if you use a scoring 'app' that doesn't have a print out facility. **I must have the number of 'A's 'C's etc - a single total is not acceptable.**

The stages will be posted out at the start of each round. Scores must be submitted to arrive not later than 5 days after the last day of each round.

All the stages are simple to set up and organisers are asked to keep to the measurements given. Targets will be **IPSC (full size) or Mini Targets (2/3)** either full or partial. These are available from Double Alpha Academy.

Alternative Start Position for handguns (Tyro)

Some clubs forbid the drawing of a loaded handgun from a holster, and some, especially new, shooters may feel uncomfortable with it. To allow for this an alternative start position is allowed. Instead of starting with the gun in the holster, the shooter starts with gun in the strong hand with elbow touching side and forearm parallel to the ground, finger outside trigger guard. The weak arm is hanging naturally by side.

Non-holstered starts, e.g. gun placed on table, remain the same for all shooters.

Round 3 Stage Construction Notes

- 1) Unless otherwise specified, the lowest point of a target or array is 1.4m from floor.
- 2) Shooting boxes are 600 x 600mm (2 x 2ft). Ideally, made from 50 x 50mm wood.
- 3) Distance to targets is from front of box or to rear of table, i.e. shooter's side.
- 4) Distances between boxes is centre to centre.

Stage 9

This stage (which also forms part of stages 11 and 12) contains both full size IPSC targets and Mini IPSC targets (2/3 size).

Stage 10

The no shoot touches the edges of T2 and T3

Stage 11

- 1) This stage is Stage 9 and 10 targetry combined.

Stage 12

- 1) This stage is Stage 9 and 10 targetry combined with the addition of a partial target T5.

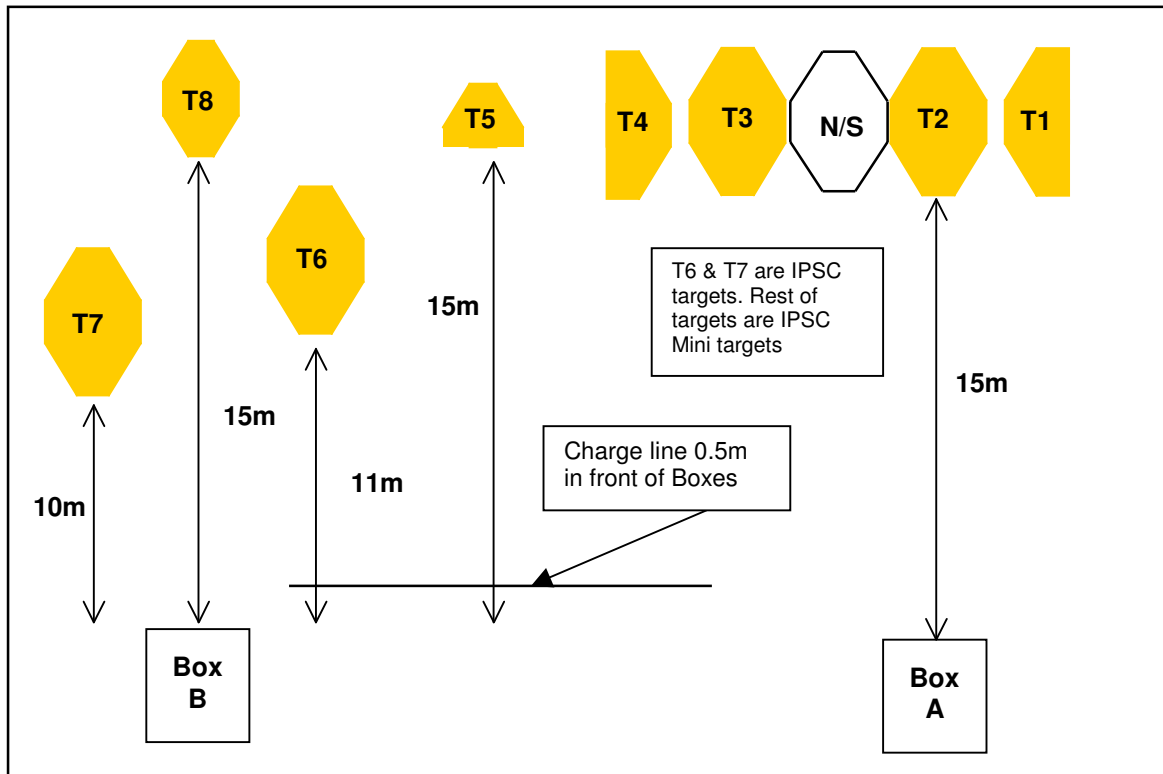
STAGE 9 INFO			
TYPE:	Short.	TARGETS:	2 IPSC, 1 IPSC Mini targets
SCORING:	Comstock.	MINIMUM ROUNDS:	12 Rounds
DISTANCES:	11 - 15m	MAX POINTS:	60 Points.
START:	Audible signal	PENALTIES:	As per current edition of IPSC Rule Book.
STOP:	Last shot.		
START POSITION:	Standing upright in Box A, Handguns - Gun loaded and in holster with arms hanging naturally by your sides. Rifles – loaded and held in two hands at hip level and parallel to the ground.		
PROCEDURE:	On the start signal engage all targets in any order with a minimum of two shots from standing freestyle. Reload with a minimum of one round and re-engage all targets in any order with a minimum of two shots from weak shoulder (rifles) or weak hand supported.		
DESIGN NOTES:	When shooter is stood naturally in box, T1, T2 and T3 should appear to be edge to edge. Box is 60 cm (2ft) square		
BRIEFING NOTES:	Safety Angles: 90 / 90 / 90. (MAR may be used)		



STAGE 10 INFO			
TYPE:	Short	TARGETS:	2 full IPSC Mini, 2 partial IPSC mini targets, 1 Mini no shoot
SCORING:	Comstock.	MINIMUM ROUNDS:	8 Rounds
DISTANCES:	15m	MAX POINTS:	40 Points.
START:	Audible signal	PENALTIES:	As per current edition of IPSC Rule Book.
STOP:	Last shot.		
START POSITION:	Sat on chair, back to targets, unloaded gun placed wholly on centerline of table. Butt to be on table (barrel may protrude over front of table. All ammunition required for the stage to be on the shooter or on table, but may not be held in hands.		
PROCEDURE:	On the start signal, load and shoot all targets with a minimum of two shots on each.		
DESIGN NOTES:	It is suggested the centreline of the table is marked, e.g. tape or patches.		
BRIEFING NOTES:	Safety Angles: 90 / 90 / 90. (MAR may be used)		



STAGE 11 INFO			
TYPE:	Medium	TARGETS:	3 full IPSC Mini, 2 partial IPSC Mini targets, 2 IPSC targets
SCORING:	Comstock.	MINIMUM ROUNDS:	14 Rounds
DISTANCES:	10 - 15m	MAX POINTS:	70 Points.
START:	Audible signal	PENALTIES:	As per current edition of IPSC Rule Book.
STOP:	Last shot.		
START POSITION:	Sat on chair, reading 'magazine' held in front of eyes and hiding targets (see design notes). Rifles and pistols condition 3 (magazine inserted / loaded, but no round in chamber and hammer down), revolvers condition 2 (hammer down on loaded chamber) placed on floor centrally in front of shooter, butt between feet.		
PROCEDURE:	On the start signal, engage all targets in any order with a minimum of two shots freestyle. Targets T1 – T3 must be taken from vicinity of chair, T4 - T7 from Box A		
DESIGN NOTES:	This is Stage 9 and Stage 10 targetry combined. Note that IPSC rules specify that all IPSC Mini targets must be AT LEAST 2m behind the nearest (to them) IPSC target. 'Magazine' is a Mini IPSC target held horizontally.		
BRIEFING NOTES:	Safety Angles: 90 / 90 / 90. (MAR may be used)

TYPE:	Medium
SCORING:	Comstock.
DISTANCES:	10 - 15m
START:	Audible signal
STOP:	Last shot.
TARGETS:	4 full IPSC Mini, 3 partial IPSC Mini targets, 2 IPSC targets
MINIMUM ROUNDS:	16 Rounds
MAX POINTS:	80 Points.
PENALTIES:	As per current edition of IPSC Rule Book.
START POSITION:	Standing upright in Box A, Handguns - Gun loaded and in holster with arms hanging naturally by your sides. Rifles – loaded and held in two hands at hip level and parallel to the ground.
PROCEDURE:	On the start signal, engage all targets in any order with a minimum of two shots freestyle. Targets T1 - T4 must be taken from Box A, T6 – T8 from Box B. Target T5 must be taken between Box A and Box B. A foot over the charge line is not a procedural error, but both feet over is.

BRIEFING NOTES:	Safety Angles: 90 / 90 / 90. (MAR may be used)
