The UKPSA 100

Winter Postal League for Long Barrelled Firearms

This is an Open Postal League for the months of November, December 2016 and January 2017. It is free to enter and all shooters are invited to participate. These are all static stages that are designed to be simple to set up and run at any club shoot. Team entries are also free.

The stages may be shot at any time over the three month period. The stages do not have to be completed in one go. Your club may choose to shoot a few stages each week.

These are standard courses of fire. Shooters may enter more than one division and must register for each division in which they shoot.

Medals will be awarded to the division winners. Other medals awarded depending on number of entrants in each division.

Please register your division as follows

Mini Rifle Open – Open	Mini Rifle Standard – Standard
LBP Open – Production	LBP Standard - Classic
LBR Standard – Revolver	Gallery Rifle - Custom

Team Entries – 3 or 4 members shooting in the same division. Best three scores to count. Team members must be bona fide members of the same club. They may enter in more than one team if shooting in a different gun division. To register your team fill in the team form and email to postalleagues@ukpsa.org. All team members must register as an individual.

Scoring – All stages will be comstock scored.

Targets - all will be the IPSC Mini Targets (2/3). The bottom of the targets will be placed 1.5 meters from the ground. Targets will have a gap of 10cm (4") between them where there are more than one in a stage. Targets can be obtained from <http://www.doublealpha.biz/targets-tape.htm>

Distances - will be measured from targets to front of shooting box or rear of table.

Start Positions There are two start positions.

Start Position 1 (SP1).

Handguns - Gun in holster. Standing up right with hands hanging naturally by your sides.

Rifles - Standing upright. Gun held in two hands at waist level either side of body and parallel to the ground

Start Position 2 (SP2).

All Firearms - Gun wholly on table. Standing upright behind table with arms hanging naturally by your side.

Start conditions will be given in each stage. All shooting must take place from the shooting box or from behind the confines of the table. Unloaded starts – ammunition may be loose or in a magazine or a speed loader.

Reloads. At least one round must be inserted into the gun. Speed loaders or magazines may be used.

Gun Divisions. Standard and Open for LBR, LBP, Mini Rifle and Lever Action Rifle.

Categories. Regular, Lady, Senior or Junior.

Major Minor Calibre. All LBP and Mini Rifle will be scored as minor. LBR and Lever Action Rifle please select major or minor when you register.

Targets – 3. Distance 20m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a minimum of two rounds on each.		6
Stage 2	UKPSA 100 - 2	
Targets – 3. Distance 15m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a minimum of two rounds on each.		6
Stage 3	UKPSA 100 - 3	
Targets – 3. Distance 10m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a minimum of two rounds on each. Handguns strong hand only, Rifles from weak shoulder.		6
Stage 4	UKPSA 100 - 4	
Targets – 3. Distance 10m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a maximum of two rounds on each. Carry out a compulsory reload and again shoot the targets with a minimum of two rounds on each.		12
Stage 5	UKPSA 100 - 5	
Targets – 2. Distance 10m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a maximum of one round on each. Carry out a compulsory reload and again shoot the targets with a maximum of two rounds on each. Carry out a second reload and engage the targets with a minimum of three rounds on each.		12
Stage 6	UKPSA 100 - 6	
Targets – 3. Distance 10m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a maximum of two rounds on each. Carry out a compulsory reload and again shoot the targets with a minimum of one round on each. Handguns strong hand only. Rifles from strong shoulder		9
Stage 7	UKPSA 100 - 7	
Targets – 3. Distance 10m. Start condition Loaded SP1. On audible start signal, shoot targets with a maximum of two rounds on each. Carry out a compulsory reload and again shoot the targets with one round on each. Handguns weak hand only. Rifles from weak shoulder		9

Stage 8 **UKPSA 100 - 8**

Targets – 3. Distance 10m. Start Condition Unloaded, SP2. All ammunition for the stage on the table, loose, in magazines or speed loaders. On audible start signal, shoot the targets with a minimum of two rounds on each.

Stage 9 **UKPSA 100 - 9**

Targets – 3. Distance 10m. Start Condition Loaded, Condition 2. SP2. On audible start signal, shoot the targets with a minimum of two rounds on each.

Stage 10 **UKPSA 100 - 10**

Targets – 3. Distance 10m. Start Condition Loaded, SP2. On audible start signal, shoot the targets with a minimum of two on each. Handguns weak hand only, Rifles from weak shoulder

Stage 11 **UKPSA 100 - 11**

Targets – 1. Distance 10m. Start Condition unloaded. SP2 All ammunition required for the stage on the table, in magazines or speed loaders. On audible start signal, shoot the target with a minimum of six rounds, freestyle.

Stage 12 **UKPSA 100 - 12**

Targets – 1. Distance 10m. Start Condition Loaded. SP2. On audible start signal, shoot the target with a minimum of six rounds.

Stage 13 **UKPSA 100 - 13**

Targets – 5. Distance 10m. Start Condition Loaded. SP1. On audible start signal, shoot the targets with a maximum of one round on each. Carry out a compulsory reload and again shoot the targets with a minimum of one round on each.
